**Important Instructions for Passengers Planning to Travel by  
Tel Aviv – New Delhi – Kochi Vande Bharat Mission Flight  
scheduled for 26 August, 2020.**

Under phase 5 of the Vande Bharat Mission, Air India is scheduled to operate a special flight on **Tel Aviv-New Delhi-Kochi** route on **26 August 2020**. Below are the important instructions for passengers interested in booking tickets on this flight:

**Eligibility:**

- **Indian National Passport Holders** are allowed to travel on this flight.
- **OCI card holders** can also travel if they fulfill the following criteria:
  - a. Minor Children born to Indian nationals abroad and holding OCI cards.
  - b. OCI card holders who wish to come to India on account of family emergency like death in family.
  - c. Couples where one spouse is an OCI cardholder and other is an Indian national and they have permanent residence in India.
  - d. University students who are OCI cardholders but whose parents are Indian citizens living in India.

- **Foreign Nationals** can travel on this flight provided they have valid travel documents/visa which has been endorsed by Embassy of India in Tel Aviv. Please note that if you have approval which was approved before 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020, the same needs to be revalidated/endorsed by Embassy of India in Tel Aviv, Israel.

**Formalities to be completed in order to board the flight:**

- All passengers who wish to book ticket on this flight have to fill in the attached Undertaking/Indemnity form and produce it at the time of check-in of flight.
- All passengers should submit self-declaration form on the online portal ([www.newdelhiairport.in](http://www.newdelhiairport.in)) at least 72 hours prior to departure of flight. They should also give an undertaking on the portal that they will undergo mandatory quarantine of 14 days i.e., 7 days paid institutional quarantine at their own cost, followed by 7 days isolation at home with self-monitoring of health. - Travelers who do not fill this online form should fill the attached self-declaration form in duplicate and present it to the Health and Immigration official in Delhi/Cochin on Arrival.

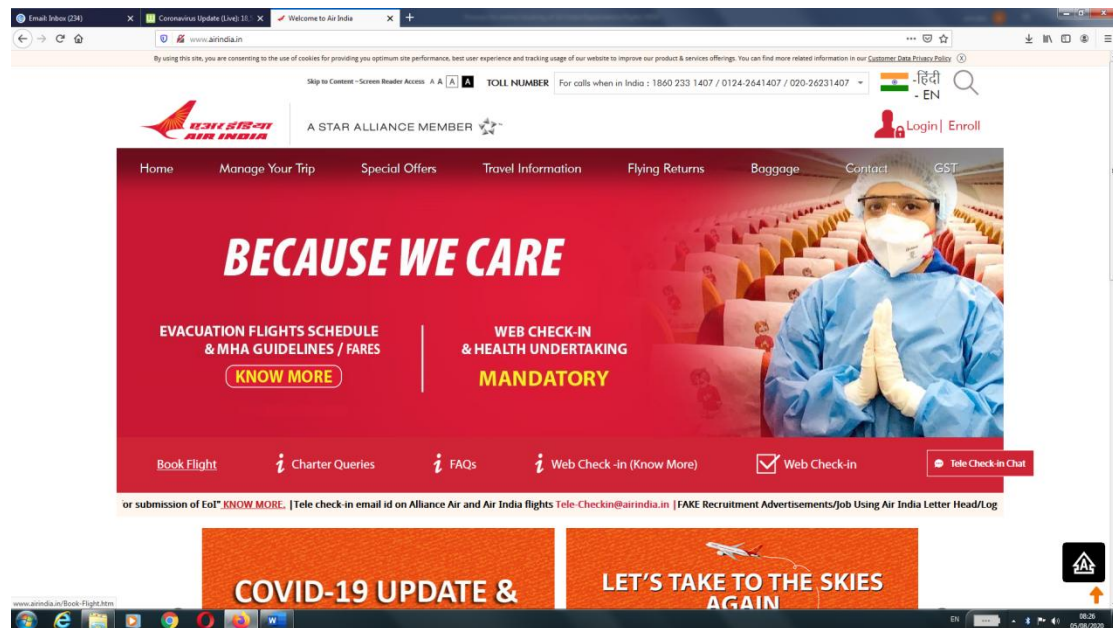
**Procedure for Booking the tickets on this flight:**

- Online ticket sales will start on **10 August 2020** from time **0930 hrs** (Israel Daylight Time) or **1200 noon** (Indian Standard time).

**Process flow for booking tickets is placed below:**

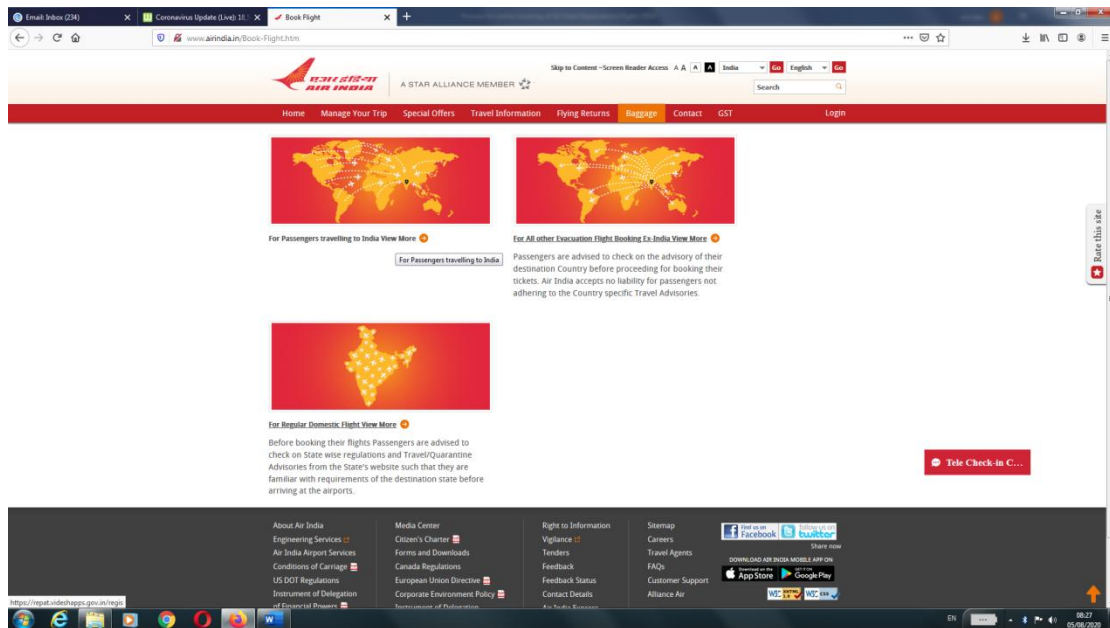
**Step 1**

Login to the Air India Website [www.airindia.in](http://www.airindia.in)



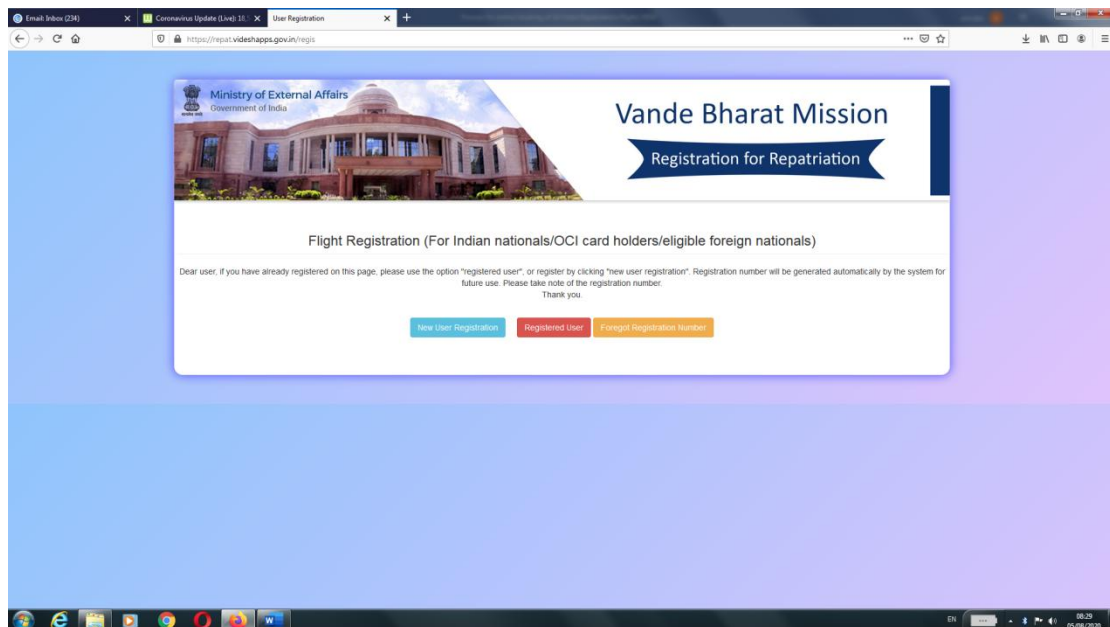
**Step 2**

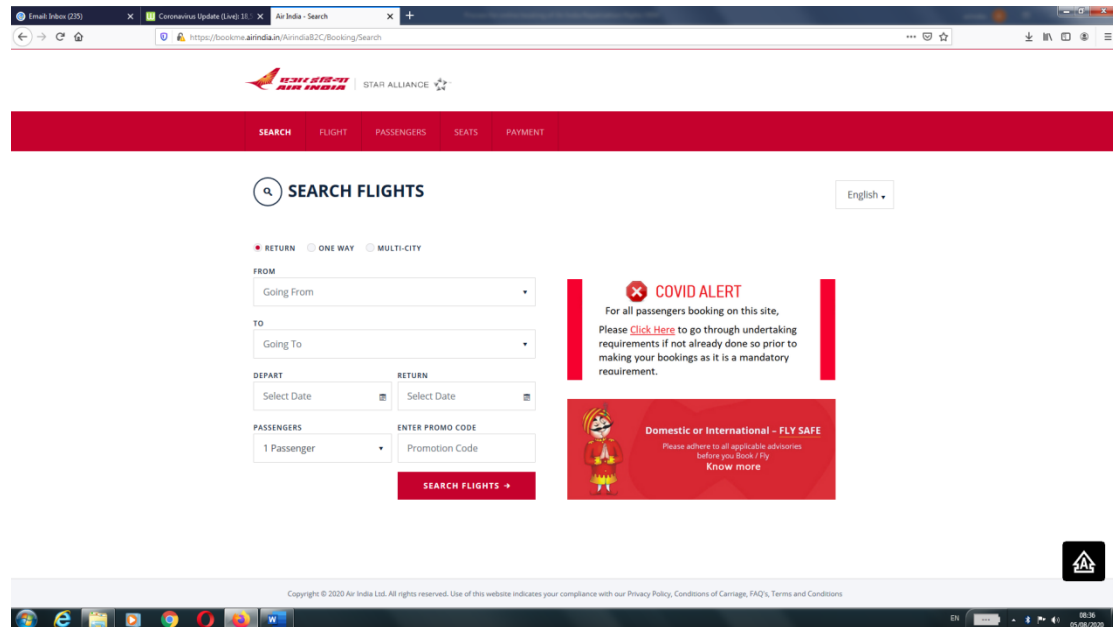

## Step 6

On this screen enter your registration number and the passport number and it will take you to the Air India booking site.



On this screen, select One Way and enter details from Tel Aviv to Delhi or Tel Aviv to Kochi and the departure date. Choose Number of passengers as 1 and click on Search Flights and follow the process, make payment to book the ticket on the flight.

### Please note the following with regard to the Baggage allowance:

- Only one piece of handbag not weighing more than 8 kgs is allowed to be taken as hand baggage for both Economy and Business class passengers. This allowance includes the laptop bag.
- **In the Economy class**, two pieces of checked-in baggage not weighing more than 23 kgs each is allowed per passenger.
- **In Business class**, two pieces of checked-in baggage not weighing 32 kgs each is allowed per passenger.
- **Air India does not have details of Hotels/Rates for quarantine requirements.** The same has to be arranged by the passengers themselves.
